



2017 FEDERAL TAX CREDITS for Renewable Energy Improvements

SECOND HOMES AND RENTALS APPLY FOR RENEWABLES

There is no maximum applied to **solar water** heaters and **solar** panels.
These are all eligible for a 30% tax credit with no upper limit through 12/31/19.

Criteria for Renewable Energy Measures (no maximum)		
Product Type	Tax Credit Specification	Tax Credit
Solar Water Heating	<p>At least half of the energy generated by the “qualifying property” must come from the sun. Homeowners may only claim spending on the solar water heating system property, not the entire water heating system of the household.</p> <p>The credit is not available for expenses for swimming pools or hot tubs.</p> <p>The water must be used in the dwelling.</p> <p>The system must be certified by the Solar Rating and Certification Corporation (SRCC).</p>	<p>30% of installed cost through 12/31/19</p> <p>26% of installed cost through 12/31/21</p> <p>22% of installed cost through 12/31/22</p>
Photovoltaic Systems	<p>Photovoltaic systems must provide electricity for the residence, and must meet applicable fire and electrical code requirement.</p>	<p>30% of installed cost through 12/31/19</p> <p>26% of installed cost through 12/31/21</p> <p>22% of installed cost through 12/31/22</p>
